

Partial closure of the Cologne main railway station from 09.-16.10.2017

Due to construction measures, there will be train cancellations and traffic delays at the Cologne main railway station and at the Köln Messe/Deutz station from 09.-16.10.2017. The following regional trains will not stop at Köln Messe/Deutz: RE1, RE8, RE9, RE12, RB38.

Diversions and time schedule alterations are also possible on other train lines. Please take note of this if you are planning your arrival by train.

Leverkusen Bridge blocked off from 07.-11.10.2017

Due to the defusing of a World War II bomb being found close to the Leverkusen Bridge, the A1 motorway is going to be completely blocked off between Leverkusen-West and Köln-Niehl heading in the direction of Koblenz from 06.10.2017 until provisionally 11.10.2017. This could lead to an increased level of traffic on the surrounding roads and motorways. The detour routes will already be signposted from Wednesday, 04.10.2017 onwards.

Two of the four lanes could be in use again on Thursday, 12.10.2017 at the earliest. Should it actually be necessary to dispose of the bomb, the motorway will be blocked off in both directions until Thursday inclusive. All four lanes are expected to be in use again by the weekend (13.-15.10.2017).

You can reach the trade fair grounds by car via the Severinsbrücke, the Deutzer Ring, the A559 eastern access road and via the Zoobrücke B55a.

Arriving at Koelnmesse via motorway A3

For those arriving via motorway A3, the best way to reach Koelnmesse is to exit onto motorway A4, not towards the city, but toward Olpe at the Köln-Ost exit. Then take exit 17 at Köln-Holweide and get right back on motorway A4 toward Koelnmesse/Zentrum.
